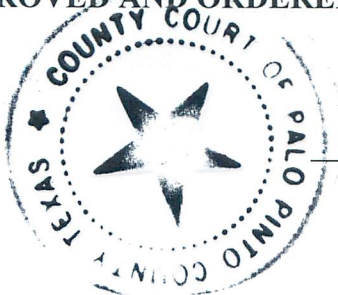
WHEREAS, the County Judge finds that conditions have improved such that the order prohibiting and restricting outdoor burning should be lifted;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec.352.081 of the Local Government Code and authorized by Commissioners Court Order on June 10, 2013;

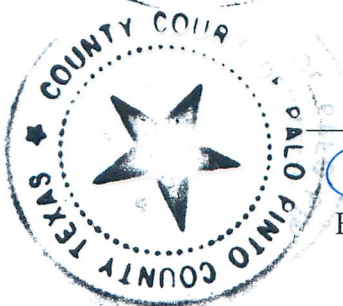
