AMENDED ORDER SUSPENDING CERTAIN PROCEEDINGS DUE TO THE COVID-19 STATE OF DISASTER

Whereas on March 13, 2020 Governor Greg Abbott declared a state of disaster in all 254 counties in the State of Texas in response to the imminent threat of the COVID-19 pandemic, the undersigned finds that the following orders are appropriate, reasonable and necessary as all non-essential, in person proceedings may pose an unnecessary or unreasonable risk to participants, court staff and the public.

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED THAT:

- All non-essential proceedings are hereby suspended and will not be heard until at least JUNE 1, 2020.
- 2. Essential proceedings are not suspended. However, the Court will conduct essential proceedings in a manner consistent with the best practices for reducing the threat of exposure to COVID-19. Essential proceedings consist of criminal magistration proceedings, CPS removal hearings, temporary restraining orders / temporary injunctions, and family violence protective orders.
- Any and all persons who are to appear before the 29th Judicial District Court who have COVID-19 or flu-like symptoms, a fever, or who are

- coughing or sneezing, are **ordered** to contact the court at the telephone number below before appearing.
