

NOTICE OF REGULAR SESSION COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF PALO PINTO COUNTY


Notice is hereby given that a Regular Session of the **Palo Pinto County Commissioner's Court** will be held on **Monday the 22nd day of January 2024 at 9:00 A.M.**, in the County Courtroom at the Palo Pinto County Courthouse. The Commissioner's Court may meet informally at 8:30 A.M. to monitor and inspect ongoing County projects. No action will be taken except at the regular session. Items on the agenda may be taken up in any order. *Interested parties and/or members of the Palo Pinto County Commissioner's Court shall assist persons with speech, physical, and/or mental disabilities if 24-hour notice is given. The following subjects will be discussed, considered, passed, or adopted to-wit:

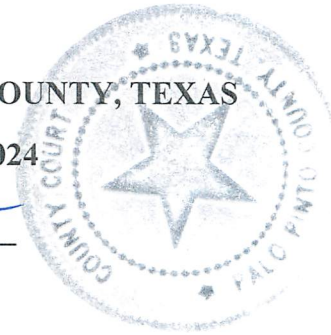
1. Call To Order;
2. Invocation;
3. Pledge of Allegiance;
4. Pledge of Texas;
5. Public Comments and announcements;
This listing is included on the agenda to allow comments, presentations, and announcements by Commissioners Court members. Any person may appear at this time and comment on a topic whether that topic appears or does not appear on this agenda. However, members of the Commissioners Court cannot discuss, deliberate, or take action on any item or topic not scheduled on this agenda in accordance with existing law. Public comments requiring possible action or deliberation may be placed on a later agenda. Comments and presentations by members of the public will be limited to a maximum of five (5) minutes unless a member of the Court requests additional time for the presenter. Any materials for handout must be furnished by the presenters.
6. Consider/approve loan from General Fund to I & S to cover 4th payment of Certificates of Obligation;
7. Approval of Accounts Payable;
8. Approval of Court Minutes;
9. Consider/Approve Auditor's monthly report;
10. Consider/Approve Treasurer's monthly report;
11. Consider/Approve Records Consultants, Inc. RCI Records Retention Update Proposal;
12. Discuss/take action on Burn Ban;
13. Consider/Approve Emergency Management monthly report to include: fires investigated, training, meetings & classes attended and inspections;

18. Consider/Approve Merchant Application and Agreements with i3 Verticals LLC, and authorize the County Judge to sign the necessary documents, to allow public access to view cases filed in the District Clerk's office and to make credit card payments;
