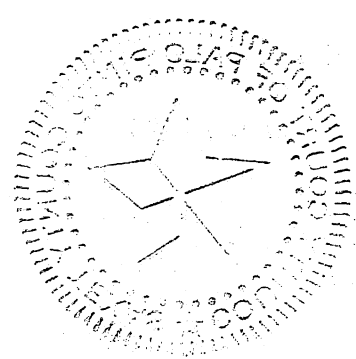

FOR THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1904
