The Commissioner's Court may meet informally at 8:30 A.M. to monitor and inspect ongoing County projects. No action will be taken except at the regular session. Items on the agenda may be taken up in any order. \*Interested parties and/or members of the Palo Pinto County Commissioner's Court shall assist persons with speech, physical, and/or mental disabilities if 24-hour notice is given. The following subjects will be discussed, considered, passed, or adopted to-wit:

Comments and presentations by members of the public will be limited to a maximum of five (5) minutes unless a member of the Court requests additional time for the presenter. Any materials for handout must be furnished by the presenters.

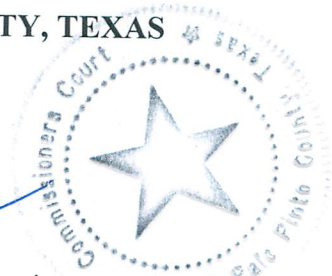
