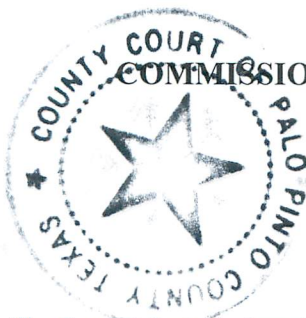

Interested parties and/or members of the Palo Pinto County Commissioners' Court shall assist persons with speech, physical, and/or mental disabilities if 24-hour notice is given.

The following subjects will be discussed, considered, passed, or adopted to-wit:

1. Discuss/Take Action on closure of alley closure, described as being a 20 foot alley in Block 12, Original Town of Santo, Palo Pinto County, said alley lying adjacent to the north side of Lots 4 thru 11 and the south side of Lot 3 and Lot 16; also a 20 foot alley in said Block 12, located south of Oak Street and lying adjacent to the west side of Lots 1 thru 3 and the east side of Lots 16 thru 18; all in Pct 4;
2. Discuss/Take Action on conveyance of property (quitclaim deed) for alley closure, described as being a 20 foot alley in Block 12, Original Town of Santo, Palo Pinto County, said alley lying adjacent to the north side of Lots 4 thru 11 and the south side of Lot 3 and Lot 16; also a 20 foot alley in said Block 12, located south of Oak Street and lying adjacent to the west side of Lots 1 thru 3 and the east side of Lots 16 thru 18; all in Pct 4;
3. Discuss/Take action on retaining outside counsel for Hobson lawsuit;
