Notice is hereby given that a Regular Session of the **Palo Pinto County Commissioner's Court** will be held on **Tuesday the 26th day of May 2026 at 9:00 A.M.**, in the County Courtroom at the Palo Pinto County Courthouse. The Commissioner's Court may meet informally at 8:30 A.M. to monitor and inspect ongoing County projects. No action will be taken except at the regular session. Items on the agenda may be taken up in any order. *Interested parties and/or members of the Palo Pinto County Commissioner's Court shall assist persons with speech, physical, and/or mental disabilities if 24-hour notice is given. The following subjects will be discussed, considered, passed, or adopted to-wit:

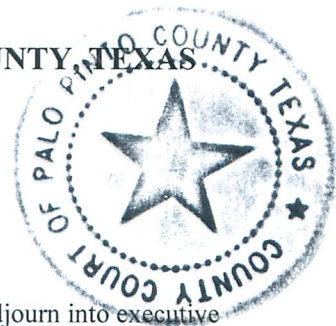

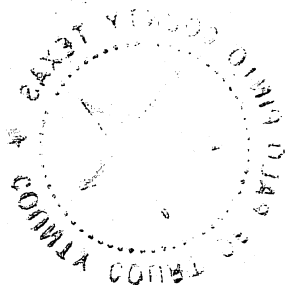
