Notice is hereby given that a Regular Session of the **Palo Pinto County Commissioner's Court** will be held on **Monday the 9th day of March 2026 at 9:00 A.M.**, in the County Courtroom at the Palo Pinto County Courthouse. The Commissioner's Court may meet informally at 8:30 A.M. to monitor and inspect ongoing County projects. No action will be taken except at the regular session. Items on the agenda may be taken up in any order. *Interested parties and/or members of the Palo Pinto County Commissioners' Court shall assist persons with speech, physical, and/or mental disabilities if 24-hour notice is given. **The following subjects will be discussed, considered, passed, or adopted to-wit:**

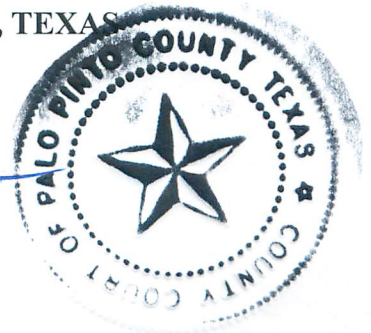
1. Call To Order;

3. Pledge of Allegiance / Pledge of Texas;
4. Public Comments and announcements;
This listing is included on the agenda to allow comments, presentations and announcements by Commissioners Court members. Any person may appear at this time and comment on a topic whether that topic appears or does not appear on this agenda. However, members of the Commissioners Court cannot discuss, deliberate or take action on any item or topic not scheduled on this agenda in accordance with existing law. Public comments requiring possible action or deliberation may be placed on a later agenda. Comments and presentations by members of the public will be limited to a maximum of five (5) minutes unless a member of the Court requests additional time for the presenter. Any materials for handout must be furnished by the presenters.
5. Consider/Accept FY2025 Independent Audit from Edgin, Parkman, Fleming & Fleming;
6. Approval of Accounts Payable;

Discuss/Take Action on petition for alley closure request, being a 20 foot alley in Block 12, Original Town of Santo, Palo Pinto County, said alley lying adjacent to the north side of Lots 4 thru 11 and the south side of Lot 3 and Lot 16; also a 20 foot alley in said Block 12, located south of Oak Street and lying adjacent to the west side of Lots 1 thru 3 and the east side of Lots 16 thru 18; all in Pct 4;
 23. Consider/Approve participation with the Leon Bosque Resource Conservation and Development (RC&D) Council;
 24. Consider/Approve yearly Netmotion renewal for the Sheriff's Office;
 25. Discuss/Take Action on canopy and lighting for the Courthouse generator;
 26. Consider/Approve Change Order PC-07 to repair upstream sanitary sewer system feeding from 8th Ave to the Wastewater Treatment Plant site;
