



ORDER RESCINDING MANDATORY EVACUATION

WHEREAS, Palo Pinto County on the 28th through 30th of June 2023, is suffering from an active wildfire, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from extreme heat, drought, and imminent threats of wildfires;

WHEREAS, On the 29th of June 2023 an order to provide appropriate public safety and care of the citizens of Palo Pinto County as well as provide for responding agency access to impacted areas. A mandatory evacuation order for residents located within the affected areas was issued.

WHEREAS, The Judge of Palo Pinto County has determined that current conditions and measures have been taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the previous order that instated a mandatory evacuation order for residents located within the areas commonly known as **Sportsman World and Gaines Bend being Gaines Bend Road to the South, SH 16 to the East, Hells Gate to the North, Bluff Creek Marina to the West** is hereby rescinded effective IMMEDIATELY on the 30th day of June 2023.

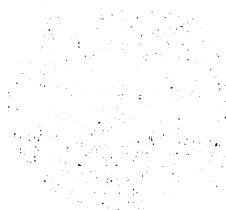
