WHEREAS, the County of Palo Pinto, Texas, deems it in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County to regulate political signs, including signs that may be placed on private property; and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes the Election Code, Title 6, Conduct of Elections, and Texas Transportation Code, Roadways; and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes Texas Department of Transportation's guidelines for political signs;

THEREFORE, the County of Palo Pinto, Texas, does hereby pass this resolution to wit:

No political sign(s) may be placed in any location that obstructs vision for traffic. Any violation of the provision of this section may be removed by the City staff or County staff if the sign creates a hazardous condition.

All political signs shall comply with all state and federal requirements, including Tex. Election Code, Chapter 255 and Section 61.003, and Tex. Trans. Code for Roadways, Chapters 392 and 393.

No political sign(s) may be placed on public property, including city and/or county right of way and road easements, except in compliance with Election Code, Chapter 43, Polling Places.

No political sign may be larger than 50 square feet and/or have any moving elements.

Political campaign signs may be posted as early as 90 days before an election (no earlier) and must be removed within 10 days after the election.
